Under Construction: A Habitat for Humanity Vacation Bible School is a fun way to help children learn about community. We will use a construction theme to teach children the value of Christian service, as well as introduce them and their families to the ministry of Habitat for Humanity. By combining solid Biblical teaching with practical, hands-on service opportunities, children and adults engage in a learning experience like no other! The Church, our Congregation, the Family of God—these are all ways of describing our community of faith. In Under Construction we learn that every gathering of believers has its own way of being in community together.

Under Construction uses the description of the first Christian community of faith found in Acts 2:44-47 to draw together our daily Bible story themes. On Sunday, we learn that The Community Shares from Exodus 35:20-29. Monday we discover that The Community Cares when we read Luke 5:17-26. Tuesday we see that The Community Learns from Acts 8:26-40. Wednesday is The Community in Worship from Joshua 24. And on Thursday The Community Celebrates together as we study Nehemiah 12:27-43.

Children 4 years through entering 6th grade are all welcome!
